As you know, the 18th ISBP Conference will be on the 2 - 4th
September 2011 in Buenos Aires (Argentina)

The title of this Conference will be:

“E-Motion: what moves us”

A conference dealing with the role of emotion, movement and
motivation in the psychotherapeutic process.

The Conference will be held at “Irenaika, Comprehensive Center for the human Person”.

The conference is located outside Buenos Aires around one and a half hour by car from the centre of the city.

The fee will be around : **€ 350/ USd \$ 483 /arg.\$ 1.967**

for sleeping (two nights), meals (for three days), transport from and to the airport, gala dinner and dancing to tango music.

It makes no sense to stay in a hotel far away from the conference centre. The conference centre is situated in a park and has among other amenities a sauna and a swimming pool.
